Dear Requesters,

I wish to notify you, through your representative, that after analyzing the information received we are proceeding to register your Request in accordance to paragraph 20 of the MICI Policy. Also, we confirm confidentiality of your identity as per your request.

The Registration phase is an administrative process to start the eligibility analysis in which MICI determines if we can process your request or not, based on the criteria of paragraph 22 of the MICI Policy. Below, I list the steps of the process that will be implemented by MICI in the coming weeks:

1. **Management’s Response:** The team responsible for the Project is being informed simultaneously of the registration of their Request so that they can respond to the issues raised, offering the perspective of the Bank's Administration. To prepare this response have a maximum period of 21 working days from today (**May 30, 2018**).
2. **Eligibility Analysis:** once we receive response from Management, within a maximum period of 21 business days we will be issuing our determination through an Eligibility Memorandum. The deadline for issuing the Memorandum is **June 28, 2018**.

During this time-frame, we will be continuously communicating with you. Also, the [Case Registry File](#) will be available in the MICI website soon, where you can consult the process of your application and all public documents of the case.

Again, we emphasize that both the MICI and the Bank's Management will give the appropriate treatment to your confidential information.
